Gender Mainstreaming Policies for Government Officers [23 to 24 January 2018 | Chiba, Japan]



The course to enhance capability of the national machinery to disseminate the perspective of gender mainstreaming and gender equality in the design, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of policies and plans in various field. was held from 23 to 24 January in collaboration with JICA. Ten Government officers engaged in planning, implementation and/or evaluation of the gender equality or gender mainstreaming in the National Machinery (Central policy coordination unit for the advancement of gender equality inside the government).

The following eight countries attended the programme: Afghanistan, Bhutan, Cambodia, Lesotho, Maldives, Papua New Guinea, Serbia and South Sudan.

Training Programme on Improving Capability in Producing Official Statistics for Monitoring the Post-2015 Sustainable Development Goals [21 August - 15 December 2017]

The course strengthened capacity of organizations belonging to National Statistical System by training statistical personal that increased their knowledge and skills to apply statistical methods to produce official statistics and indicators and use these for monitoring progress in achieving the SDGs.

26 participants from 15 countries succeeded in the final test and gained certificates.
