

UNEP's role in the IAEG-SDGs

UNEP supports the work of Inter-agency and Expert Group on SDG Indicators (IAEG-SDGs) in developing environment-related indicators and in supporting the broader work of the UNSC in improving environmental monitoring and developing and implementing statistical standards:

- development of metadata of SDG indicators for which UNEP is the lead (30 indicators), co-lead, or supporting (additional 50 indicators)
- methodology development, disaggregation and aggregation of data
- yearly reporting on progress on SDG indicators for the Secretary
- General's SDG progress report

UNEP also works with other agencies involved in statistical standard development to ensure that environmental statistical standards such as SEEA and the Framework for the Development of Environment Statistics are fit for purpose
