Activities

- Armenia is a Member of the Inter-Agency and Expert Group on Sustainable Development Goal Indicators (IAEG-SDGs).
- The third meeting of the IAEG-SDGs, from 30 March to 1 April 2016 in Mexico City, Mexico.
- The fourth meeting of the IAEG-SDGs, will be held from 18 to 21 October 2016 in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia.





Monitoring national development plans

- National Statistical Service of the Republic of Armenia cooperates with the international agencies and coordinates the activities within the country.
- Meetings with stakeholders have been organized to discuss:
- ✓ Indicators framework
- ✓ Legal basis and mechanisms for data collection
- ✓ Coordination and cooperation issues.





Data and statistics for SDGs

Organizational arrangements

- National Council for Sustainable Development of the Republic of Armenia.
- Prospective Development Strategy of the Republic of Armenia for 2014-2025.
- Armenia's UN Development Assistance Framework (UNDAF) is the program of cooperation between the UN system and the Government of Armenia, 2016 - 2020. The key results expected from cooperation are aligned with the priorities established in the Armenia Prospective Development Strategy 2014-2025 and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).





Gap analysis

Self-assessment

- 105 (42.9 %) indicators, fully compliant with the definition
- 94 (38.4 %) indicators, mostly compliant with the definition
- ❖ 34 (13.8 %) indicators, partly compliant with the definition
- ❖ 12 (4.9 %) indicators, problematic





Future plan of actions

- To nationalize SDGs in Armenia
- To develop a monitoring and evaluation system
- To implement Capacity building projects UNICEF, IOM, UNIDO, UNECE, UNESCAP, UNEP, EEA, WFP, the WB, Eurostat, CIS, FAO





National Strategies for the Development of Statistics

- Three-year State Statistical Work Program of the Republic of Armenia for 2016-2018, approved by the Parliament as a Law on 29 December 2015.
- Post-2015 Development Agenda. Sustainable Development Goals indicators, indicted as a priority statistics area, Item 88, PART 4.
 INTERNATIONAL STATISTICAL COOPERATION.



Challenges



Lack of:

- > methodology
- data and data sources
- ➤ level of disaggregation
- > quality of administrative registers
- institutional infrastructure
