- National development goals: Growth of employment Increase in employment through creation of quality and wellpaid jobs is recognized as the main objective of ADS. By 2021, the Government aims to ensure employment growth of around 135,000.
- **SDGs:** 8. Promote sustained, inclusive and sustainable economic growth, full and productive employment and decent work for all;
- 8.5 by 2030 achieve full and productive employment and decent work for all women and men, including for young people and persons with disabilities, and equal pay for work of equal value;
- 8.6 by 2020 substantially reduce the proportion of youth not in employment, education or training at all levels.

- SDGs: 8.5.2. Unemployment rate, by sex, age and persons with disabilities
- SDGs: 8.6.1. Proportion of youth (aged 15-24 years) not in education, employment or training
