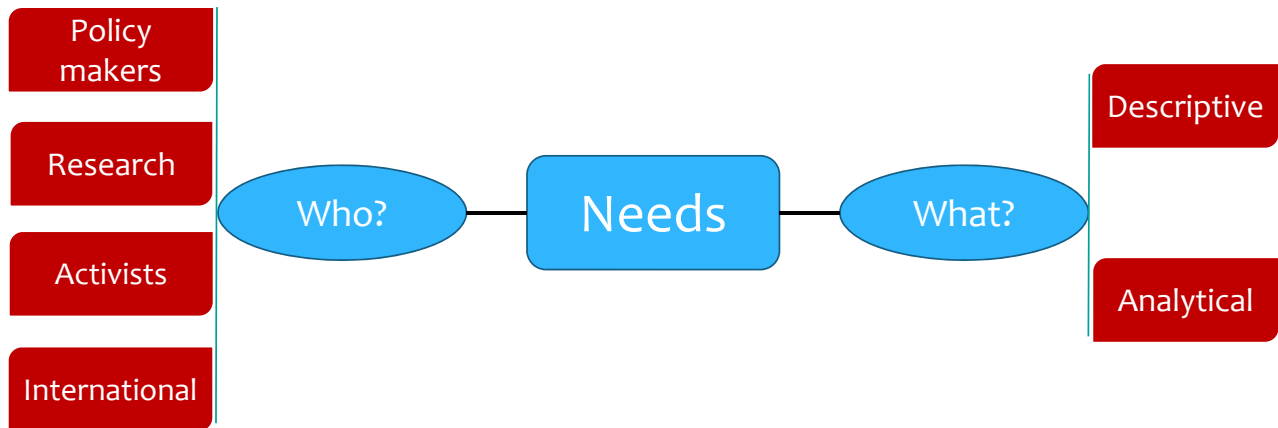

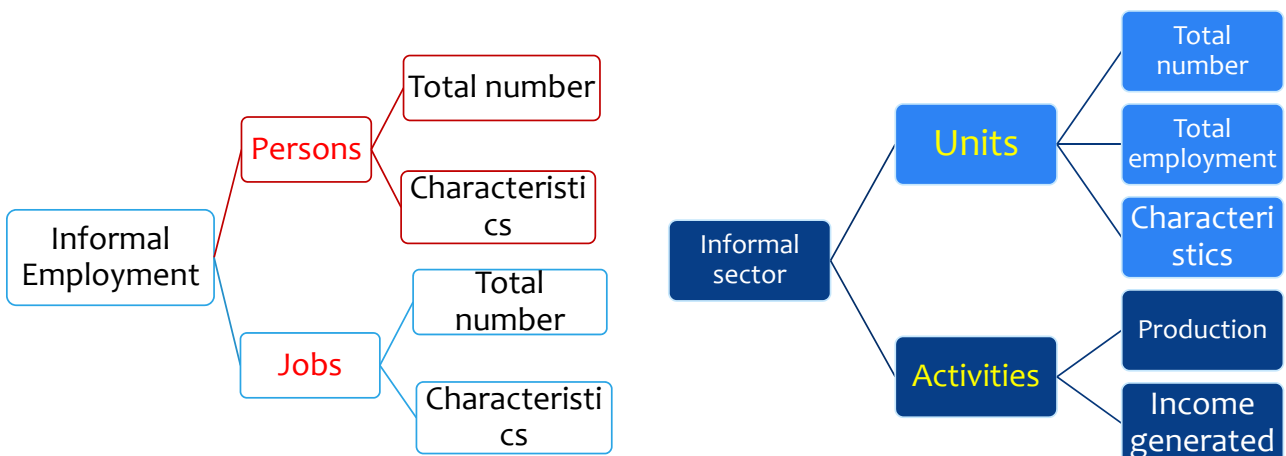

Statistics produced for *(Informal jobs, persons, establishments, etc)*

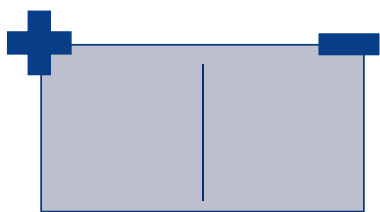
