


Institutional Mechanisms for Gender Mainstreaming

- Led by the Ministry of Social Welfare, Relief and Resettlement.
- Myanmar National Committee for Women's Affairs, an interministerial policy-related mechanism established in 1996 and reestablished in 2012 under the new government to implement the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women (CEDAW) and the Beijing Platform for Action;
- Myanmar Maternal and Child Welfare Association, which was established in 1991 to promote maternal and child health and well-being in remote areas.






Objective



The NSPAW is the main policy document in Myanmar that is explicit on gender issues.


NSPAW is based on the 12 Priority Areas







