- A three-year project in Cambodia, Colombia, Mongolia and Uganda
- Providing tailored assistance in GCED curriculum development and integration and sustainable implementation
- Situational analysis to assess the different needs of the countries
- Capacity-building workshops

Policy Guide on GCED



- Aims to introduce to policy-makers the necessary direction and the grounds when they establish policies embodying GCED
- The draft of this Guide has primarily been reviewed online by 100 international GCED experts and more than 300 feedback has been reflected
- To be published by the end of 2017 after a final revision



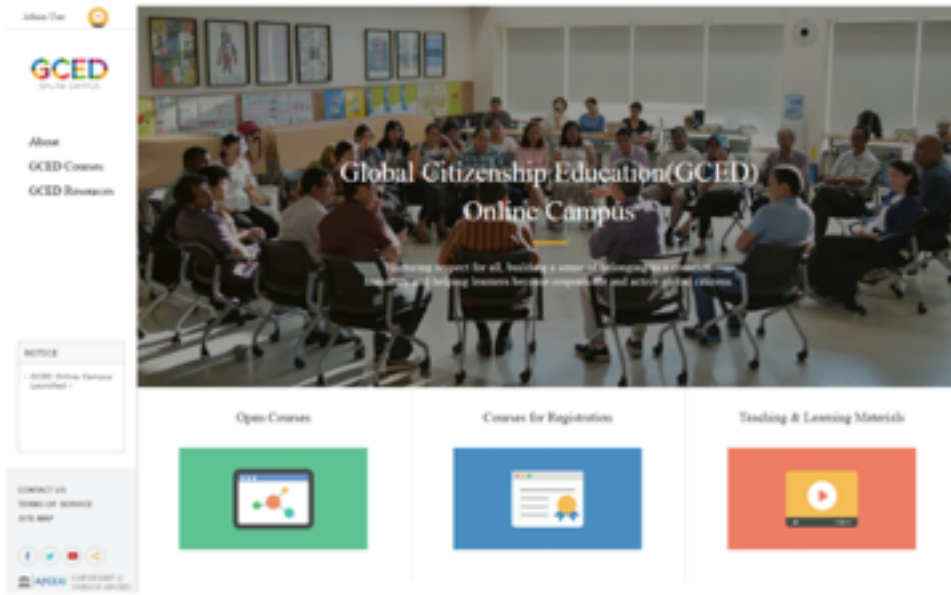

SangSaeng

Sangsaeng is an English magazine published three times a year that is a platform for constructive discussion of EIU issues, methods and experiences in the field of education for international understanding-including education for peace, human rights, cultural diversity and sustainable development. SangSaeng (상생잡지) is originated from a word with two Chinese characters: 相 and 生. Sang (相) means 'mutual' (each other) and Saeng (生), meaning 'life'. Put together, they mean "living together" and "helping each other".

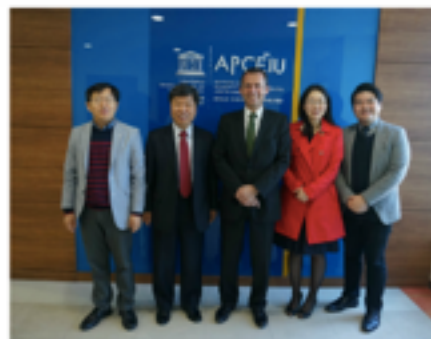
