
Regulations and legal acts




Based on a first EU Regulation, in 1993 national statistical institutes launched the development of SBRs to underpin European business statistics.

- Notwithstanding efforts to harmonise definitions and methodologies, SBRs developments mainly reflected national circumstances and needs.
- Thus, national business registers differed from each other in terms of the sources used, the content, the frequency of updating, the methodology, etc.
