
Recipe to delineate SUs


- 1. Delineate Legal Units and their Establishments
- 2. Investigate the organisational, financial and economic relationships between Legal Units
- 3. Delineate the operational structure of the EG by selecting groups of Legal Units bounded by an 'Control'-Relation >= 51%
- 4. Delineate the ENTs in an EG
- 5. Delineate the Local Units within an ENT
- 6. Link the Legal Units to the ENT



Delineation of SUs










Advantages


- 1. Information in a snapshot is coordinated because it's time-stamped and reproducible at any moment in time.
- 2. The quality of the units (and characteristics) used in a chain of statistical processes are traceable.
- 3. Storage of coordinated populations at one central place. This eases the extraction of information by the business.
- 4. Storage of coordinated populations is separated from the Liveenvironment of the SBR (Business Architecture).
- 5. Simplification of datamodel supports easier usage by the business.



CFE:


Service users, who can be individuals or corporations, which have contracts for the supply of electric service. They are classified as domestic and non-domestic users.




