

## Regional Training on Producing Register-based Population Statistics in Developing Countries

e-Learning Module (Online): 23– 27 September 2013  
Face-to-Face Module: 27-31 October 2013, Tehran, Islamic Republic of Iran

### **Introduction**

This self-paced e-learning activity is the first module of a blended [e-learning followed by face-to-face (F2F)] regional training on “*Producing Register-based Population Statistics in Developing Countries*” which is conducted jointly by SIAP and UNFPA, in collaboration with Statistical Centre of Iran (SCI), Government of Islamic Republic of Iran.

Only nominated participants who successfully complete the e-learning phase will be accepted to participate in the F2F module to be held from 27 to 31 October 2013 in Tehran, Islamic Republic of Iran. The participants nominated to participate in the training will have to satisfactorily complete (complete three quizzes and secure at least 80% score in the course-competition test) the e-learning module during 23 to 27 September 2013.

### **Objectives**

The regional training aims to improve practical knowledge and skills of official statisticians in producing register-based population statistics. The e-learning module will provide basic information and statistical background essential for understanding the rationale, objectives and preconditions for producing register-based population statistics.

### **Course structure**

The e-learning module consists of three lessons, three quizzes and final test. Participants are required to start with lesson one and can proceed to the next lessons only after completing quiz after each lesson. After completing quiz for lesson three on “*using administrative data in production of population statistics; register-based surveys*”, participants are ready to take the course-completion test. To secure the qualifying score of minimum 80% in the test, participants are allowed to take the test as many times as they like. *By securing minimum 80% score in the test and completing all three quizzes, participant will be qualified for the F2F module of the training.*
