

<u>WHAT</u>: Solution or change you would like to see relative to your advocacy issue

<u>HOW</u>: Specific action a decision-maker or decision-making institution can take to accomplish the change

WHEN: Date or time frame for the action to occur

## 4 Elements of a Policy Advocacy Goal


WHAT: Solution or change you would like to see relative to your advocacy issues
