

Official languages: English, Fijian, Fiji Hindi


National Statistical System

Statistical governance (council, advisory body, etc.)


• Efforts have been made, however, not functional **Statistics and policy**



Role of the Department


- Collect, compile, abstract, analyse and publish statistical information.
- Collaborate with government departments and other agencies in the collection, abstraction, analysis and publication of statistical records.
- Conduct a census of the population of Fiji as required.

The Statistics Act (CAP. 71 Ed. 1978) needs to be revised

System

- Consistency in providing high quality, objective and responsive statistical services

Statistics Relating to Agriculture

Overview of work statistics

- *Agriculture is widely scattered in the country and the economic function they perform in channeling the flow of goods from the producers to the consumers is of great importance.
- *These agriculture contribution account for a substantial proportion of the total economic activity pertaining to Agriculture sector, in terms of GDP or in terms of its share of total employment and Gross Capital Formation(GFCF)
- *These Agriculture Statistics are used to construct the input-output table that shows the inter-connection of the Agriculture sector with other industries.
- *Policy makes require the data for formulating sound economic and social policies that augment capital formation
