




2. Go to the MY QUESTIONNAIRES tab




3. Select the questionnaire 'Questionnaire 1: Basic Designer', then select *COPY*.




4. Name the questionnaire 'Questionnaire 3: Intermediate Designer'




5. Click on the section icon on the left hand side and click *ADD NEW SECTION*. Create the second section '*Additional Information*'. Click *SAVE*.



6. Add a new question




7. Create a numeric question as shown below




8. Add a Roster




9. Tie this roster to the number of pets question. Make the Roster ID *Pets* and the Roster Name *PetRoster*. Leave the Source of names of row blank for now (we will come back to this). Click *SAVE*.




10. Add a question to the Pet Roster by right-clicking on the roster and selecting Add question.




11. Add the question asking each pet's name. The variable name is *PetName*, the variable label is *Pet Name*, and the question text is 'What is the name of pet number %Pets%?'. To save, click SAVE.




12. Go back the Roster definition and set the pet name question as the source question for names of rows.



13. Add another question to the roster by right clicking on the pet name question and selecting 'Add question after'.




14. This is a single-select question. The variable name is *Animal*, the Variable label is *Animal Type*, and the Question text is '*What type of animal is 'PetName'*'. Add the 6 options *cat, dog, fish, pony, turtle, other*. Complete this question by clicking *SAVE*.




15. Add a new question that is not in the roster using the ADD QUESTION button.



16. Notice that the roster questions are indented. And the new question is not.




17. Questions can be move and put into rosters by dragging it




18. Drag the question out of the roster and fill the information as below.








Use
br> to insert a line break.

Italic

Use <i> to begin the use of italics. Then, use </i> when you want to discontinue the use of italics.

Underline

Use <u> to begin the use of underline. Then, use </u> when you want to discontinue the use of underline.

Size

Big. Use

sig> to begin the larger text. Then, use </big> to discontinue the larger text.

Small. Use <small>to begin the smaller text. Then, use </small> to discontinue the smaller text.

Script

Subscript. Use _{to begin subscript. Then, use} to discontinue style.

Superscript. Use ^{to begin superscript. Then, use} to discontinue style.
