

Capitalize on Synergies

Country-driven

- Demand-driven rather than supply-driven
- Based on training needs assessment
- Integration within statistical system

Value-added of regional approach

- Regional goals and targets
- Facilitate shared understanding among stakeholders
- Create supply of training that address common needs
- Networking: coordination; South-South cooperation; knowledge sharing and management



Differing Starting Points ...

- in Level of capacity across countries and within countries
- in *Priority needs* for data, statistics and indicators

Aiming for Sustainability

TIPs

National training institute partners are both target stakeholders and implementing partners

Standardization

Is a capacity-building process

Resulting in standardized syllabi, materials and training modalities

Integration

TIPs integrate training on A & R Statistics in their work programme





Stakeholders of Agricultural & Rural Statistics



Stakeholder Needs

Area of concern and development issues

- Knowledge and understanding on concepts and interpretation of indicators relevant to the development issue
- Appropriate level of understanding of the core items, associated data and the statistical methods (and problems) that underpin the generation of the indicators



A Note on Issues

- In your group work reports under theme IV, you brought out many of the needs of the statisticians
- Statisticians are also stakeholders of this process

Theory Into Practice

- What do you want the trainee to be able to do? (Outcome)
- What does the trainee need to know in order to do this well? (Syllabus)
- What activity will facilitate the learning? (Pedagogy)
- How will the trainee demonstrate the learning? (Assessment)
- How will I, the trainer, know the trainee has done this well? (Criteria)




Learning Objectives Guide the ...

- Selection of content
- Development of training strategy
- Development and selection of training materials
- Construction of tests and other instruments for assessing and evaluating
- Improvement of the course and the trainer


