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# 1 Statistical Training courses



- The Institute is the only training institute specialized in statistics established in the government, targeting all the personnel of national and local governments.
- The Institute provides 18 training courses in a year: various levels of statistical training courses from introductory courses for general personnel to specialized courses for higher level statistical personnel.

#### [Comprehensive Course] (1 course)

 The Comprehensive Course aims to provide basic statistical theories and methodologies of statistical analysis, and a wide range of applied skills in three months.


#### **[Thematic and Specialized Courses]** (17 courses)

- Thematic Courses include: National Accounts, Demography, Economic Analysis, Survey Methodology, Microdata Analysis, etc.
- Specialized Courses include the following two subjects of courses;
  - Distance Learning (E-learning) Courses through the internet since 2004
    Regional Statistical Seminar designed for local personnel to gain basic statistical knowledge, held in the local area.


#### 2 E-learning courses



E-learning courses are provided to national & local government staff.








### An example of screen





# Changes in statistics training graduates



fiscal year	2012	2011	2000	2009
Total courses	1133	988	956	937
ELearning courses	378	342	219	214
Basic	216	152	139	122
Schooling	67	58	25	41
Intermediate	95	67	55	51

Since its founding in 1921, the total number of graduates is about 26,000 in 2012 fiscal year-end
