Methodology of assessment

To assess the needs for external training on each topic:

$$V=R-P$$

V: Volume of external training needs

R:Number of officials required to be trained

P:Number of participants of the courses covering the topic conducted by the national STIs



Methodology of assessment


To assess the training provided externally on each topic:

- V: Volume of training provided by the external providers
- T: Number of officials trained in the topic in a year by another STI or development partner
