Lessons – Lao PDR



- Basic training should be localized to be effective
- Use of a local language is effective in training
- Inter-agency collaboration utilizes all available capacity
- You can train more staff across the country with tailored training packages

Lessons – Maldives and Nepal



Maldives

- Participative learning stimulated by local language
- Interagency collaboration raises NSO profile
- More effective if audience is profiled by skill level

Nepal

- Training should target a specific audience
- Senior management involvement in training critical
- Identify clear training goals and objectives
