A. Graduate School of Economics, Tokyo International University

A1. Target Participants

Participants who have successfully completed one of the following SIAP courses:

- A1-1. 6-month Group Training Course
 - 1st to 20th Group Training Course in General Statistics
 - 1st to 9th Group Training Course in Practical Statistics
 - 1st to 6th Group Training Course in Modules on Core Official Statistics
 - 1st to 4th Group Training Course in Modules on Fundamental Official Statistics

- A1-2. 2-month Group Training Course¹
 - 1st to 5th Group Training Course in Analysis and Interpretation of Statistics
 - 1st to 3rd Group Training Course in Analysis and Interpretation of Official Statistics

A2. Eligibility for Application

Applicants should

- have obtained a bachelor's degree;
- have completed 16 years of school education outside Japan; and
- have sufficient command of English to study in the English programme

A3. Application Procedures

- A3-1. Obtain the Application Form Kit "Application and Guide to Graduate School Admission – Major in Economics for Master's Degree Graduate School of Economics" from TIU (see contact details below).

- A3-2. Submit to TIU the required documents including the following by registered express mail:
 - Admission Application Slip (Prescribed Form) with photograph
 - Completed Return Address Seal (Prescribed Form)
 - Research Plan (about 2,000 words)
 - Certificate of College Graduation
 - Certificate of College Academic Records

Note: Recommendation letter of the Director of SIAP will be sent directly to TIU upon their request.

¹ Following courses conducted through English-Russian interpretation are not applicable:

- Area-Focused Training Course in Collection, Analysis and Interpretation of Statistics, and Medium/Long-Term Economic Forecasting for Central Asian Countries conducted in 2001;
- Area-Focused Training Course in Collection and Analysis of Official Statistics for Central Asian Countries conducted in 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005; and
- Area Focused Training Course in Collection and Analysis of Official Economic Statistics for Central Asian Countries conducted in 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009.
