Stakeholder analysis

- Are there established relationships?
- What do they think of the performance of NSO?
- Are we listening to what they need, do we deliver what they want?
- Do we help other agencies meet their statistical needs?
- Are the statistics comparable in terms of classifications, methodology?
- Do they control our budget?
- Do they have confidence in our data?
- Can they access it?
