O. Overview of Training Course







General Objective

- Strengthen capacity of NSOs and national planning agencies to undertake strategic planning for statistical development (NSDS);
- Introduce the NSDS processes and the ADAPT tool to aid in the following areas in response to data needs from national development plans and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs):
 - policy and statistics coherence
 - coordination of the NSS
 - identifying data gaps

 - The National Statistical Office (NSO) appreciates its leading and coordinating role and its accountability in developing, implementing and monitoring the NSDS
 - The national development planning agencies appreciates its role and contributions to generating the needed data to inform policies and decisions, and its important inputs in the NSDS making use of the ADAPT tool
 - The NSDS is seen as a permanent statistics governance mechanism and ADAPT tool as a value-added to national planning process
