Opposition or Resistance

- * Is a common challenge to advocacy efforts.
- * Be prepared.
- * Know who and why.

Possible Reasons?

- Too busy and have no time.
- Fundamentally not in agreement with your issue.
- Fear that your issue with take away limited funds from their own issue.
- Feel that they just recently changed the relevant policy and don't want to revisit it yet.

Dealing with Opposition

- Know the opposition and their motives.
- Identify their tactics and arguments.
- * Assess the risks and benefits of confronting them.
- * Mitigate their influence.
- * Pick the right partnerships.

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Obstacles to Advocacy Goals: What may keep you from success?



Possible obstacles ...

- Lack of funds for advocacy activities
 - Limited staff or capacity
- Lack of coordination among key ministries
- Poor economic climate
- Vacancies in key decision-makers posts
- Upcoming elections
- Lack of country-specific evidence
- Relevant policy is not scheduled to be revised
- Lack of long-term support for the change you want to implement
