

Survey program in agriculture sector

- The agricultural, rural and fishery census (every 5 years in past but now, every 10 years);
- 2. Crop area survey (season);
- 3. Crop yield survey (season);
- 4. Livestock survey (4 rounds);
- Fishery survey (aquaculture: twice; marine fishing survey: monthly);
- 6. Forestry survey (every year);



Objectives of cost of production survey

- Measure and provide detailed cost of specific items regarding production of paddy
- ✓ Give inputs to calculate total factor productivity of farming paddy
- ✓ To meet the need of policy-makers to identify the set of incentives and interventions that can help farmer to get enough profits and feel safety when they are involved in producing paddy (to maintain food security of nation)

^{*} The cost of production survey was conducted by GSO in 2006. At present, GSO doesn't have cost of production survey.



Sample unit

Cost survey was conducted in some provinces which was representative for regions in whole country. Viet Nam has 6 economic regions

- Red River Delta
- Northern Midland and Mountain Areas
- North Central and Central Coastal Areas
- Central Highlands
- South East
- Mekong River Delta

Number of sample units: 2000 households (for paddy); 1900 households (for pig); 500 households (for coffee)



Questionnaires

1. Identification Information:

- Full Name of household head
- Address
- Sex
- Ethnic group

2. Information of area

- Season
- Cultivated area
- Harvested area



Questionnaires

- **3. Production Information**: total production of paddy under harvested area
- 4. List of cost of production
- Seed
 - + self produce
 - + buy or gift
- Fertilizer: ure, npk, manure,...
- Pesticide, insecticide,
- Fuel
- Electricity



Questionnaires (cont)

- Irrigation water
- Depreciation cost
- Repairs
- Insurance cost (if available)
- Rental land (including opportunity cost of land if household owned land)
- Interest on loan
- Custom operation: technical services, commercial drying,
- Hired machine without driver for production of paddy
- Transport



Questionnaires (cont)

- Labour cost
 - + Hired labour: preparation for land, harvesting, protection, etc
- + Unpaid labour: preparation for land, harvesting, protection, etc (measured by hours * market price at local)

Challenges

- Estimate unpaid labour cost: lack of information regarding market price for some locality, in which people do the farming work because they cant find other job.
- Respondents sometime answer question without concentration or they don't want spend more time for interviewing.
- Overload work, budget, or lack of educated enumerators,...


