POTENTIAL SUPPORT – FUTURE SEEA PRODUCTION AND USE EFFORTS

ESCAP SUPPORT

- Online support for queries on data collection, diagnostic assessments, and needs for various SEEA accounts. Country counterparts could provide sample of data collected from various stakeholders, and ESCAP could review against SEEA accounting requirements;
- Preparation of regional or country template (e.g., water, energy, waste, land, air emissions account) with formulas and guidance on data;
- Clarification and discussion of issues and challenges, ways to progress data collection and collation tasks – country counterparts to initiate and ESCAP could verify via online means. This could include review of draft accounts and troubleshoot technical issues;
- In-country capacity building and finalization of accounts could be considered based on progress made and resources depending. Requires a formal country request.
- Online and face-to-face training programs ongoing resources depending.
- Most SEEA training materials online (<u>communities.unescap.org/environment-statistics</u>)
- Regional expert workshops (energy, waste?)
