To showcase (with data and narrative) how your business identifies and addresses impacts and risks and leverages opportunities; and to explain how your business strategy contributes to sustainability

To hold the company accountable for making progress towards societal goals

CoP Digital Platform

Both requirements will be completed through the new CoP digital platform

COP QUESTIONNAIRE | PURPOSE



This new accountability and transparency mechanism is designed to be specifically connected to the Ten Principles.

The enhanced questionnaire enables participants to:

- Learn and identify gaps in current sustainability performance
- Measure and demonstrate progress on the Ten
 Principles in a more standardized way
- Compare performance with peers on issues connected to Ten Principles and the SDGs

COP QUESTIONNAIRE | OVERVIEW

- → Contains 43-80 questions connected to our ten principles (governance, human rights, labour, the environment and anti-corruption)
- → Designed to help operationalize and accelerate action on the Ten Principles and SDGs
- → Aligned with the UNGP on Business and Human Rights (including questions on commitment, action/prevention, stakeholder engagement, tracking progress, remediation) and ILO conventions
- → Question answers are mostly in multiple choice, but also in quantitative and narrative format
- → Builds on and aligns with existing reporting frameworks and standards
- → All questions are mandatory and must completed prior to submitting

THE QUESTIONNAIRE IS ORGANIZED INTO FIVE SECTIONS

ABOUT THE ACCESS AND USE OF COP DATA

- Most questions of the CoP questionnaire are in multiple-choice and quantitative format, which facilitates aggregation and visualization of answers
- All CoP responses will be publicly available on the UN Global Compact website
- The CoP will constitute one of the largest, free public repositories of corporate sustainability information
- The UN Global Compact will do aggregated analysis of the CoP data, but will do no scoring or ranking associated with the CoP questionnaire
- UN entities and governments are encouraged to use CoP to inform their decision making (e.g. inform their programmatic work and governments, inform SDG monitoring, inform VNRs processes)
