Sub-Regional Training Course on Computer Assisted Personal Interviewing (CAPI) for Survey/ Censuses and Use of ICT tools-STATA- for Survey Data Analysis



SIAP in conjunction with the Pacific Community (SPC) and the World Bank conducted a sub-regional training course on Computer Assisted Personal Interviewing (CAPI) for Survey/Censuses and Use of ICT tools-STATA- for Survey Data Analysis from 27 March - 7 April 2017 in Nadi, Fiji. Seventeen participants from national statistical offices and other national agencies in Cook Islands, Fiji, Kiribati, Samoa, Tonga, Tuvalu, and Vanuatu participated in the training.

The workshop focused on the production of timely Agricultural and Rural Statistics through adoption of new technologies for data collection and analysis. Throughout the two weeks, participants worked through lessons, case studies, hands-on exercises and discussions in order to master the software features; understand the practices for managing survey equipment; and perform analysis on the resulting data.

During the training there was a lively and informative exchange of lessons learnt within the region. Feedback regarding the course was generally positive, with particular emphasis on the benefit of activities to cement knowledge.

Regional Workshop on Training of Trainers for Official Statistics

To support statistical training providers in the Asia-Pacific region to assess training needs, design and deliver statistical training programmes for official statisticians working at National Statistical Systems (NSSs) in a more harmonized form and with higher quality, SIAP organized a Training of Trainers (ToT) workshop 21 to 24 March 2017. The ToT workshop drew senior officials from institutes providing training on official statistics in the Asia-Pacific region to share best practices regarding training design and facilitation. The workshop also focused to equip participants with the improved skills in designing, developing and delivery of training on official statistics with focus on agricultural and rural statistics. Regional Training Course on Integrated Economic Statistics to support 2008 SNA Implementation

The Regional Course on Integrated Economic Statistics to support 2008 SNA implementation was held from 18 to 21 April 2017 in Bangkok by SIAP and ESCAP Statistics Division. The course is a part of the Regional Programme for Improving Economic Statistics in the Asia-Pacific region. 15 participants from seven countries participated in the course and enhanced their capacity to improve the quality of economic censuses, surveys and their integration in the compilation of national accounts.
