Workgroup 1

- A Goals of network (section 1 A)
 - Re the goal of "aligning programs to national and international priorities" It may not be possible to align everything but it should be possible to have alignment in most areas and cater for differences through outreach programs and country specific courses
 - Keep emphasis on practical courses which will meet the needs of small countries.
- B Participating Agencies
 - Not all agencies will have dedicated staff or an academic staff. They may be hired on contract basis or be provided by other agencies (including international agencies and other NSOs)

• C. Steering Committee

- Agreed that we should have a committee.
- Smaller agencies must have a voice so it should have membership with representatives from small, large, developed and developing countries of the region, international and donor agencies
- If every country is represented it will be too large and unwieldy – have representatives of regions and groups with some rotation of membership within groups.
- Try and get an overall balance of subject matters (eg. Mix of economic and demography)
- NSA chiefs could be members where agencies don't have heads of training.
- International members yes
- Include scope for invitees for specific issues

IV BASIC FEATURES

A Library

 Start with the SIAP e-library and add to this collections and additions from member agencies in incremental way as new material is produced

B Publications

- Not everyone will be able to produce reference articles
- This concept should be broader to include "learning resources" which will include handbooks, course notes, tools, exercises

• C Training Programs

Add "sample survey methodology" as a core area

- V ELEMENTS OF THE NETWORK
- A The Internet.
 - Recognise that this is very ambitious. Many agencies will not be able to publish all this content but the list provides a good vision to work towards.
- B Regular interactions
 - Regular interactions are necessary. Not all agencies will have capacity to initiate but all will benefit from participation.
- C Exchange of staff
 - Need not be an "exchange" could be temporary attachment

- V ELEMENTS OF THE NETWORK (cont)
- D High Level Visits
 - What role should the network play in the area of "high level visits"? Is it necessary to facilitate them? They are valuable instruments.
- E Expected Overall Results
 - Need to set some ambitious goals and measure progress so that we know the network is delivering real value.

VI FINANCING THE NETWORK

- Appropriate to seek a modest membership fee from members
- Seek contributions from leading donor agencies (seed money)
- Seek sponsorship for specific activities
- Course fees also appropriate
- Aim for self reliance
