Four Thrusts in Statistical Cooperation in ASEAN

- Support for ASEAN initiatives
- Harmonization of statistics
- Promotion of international standards and best practices
- Promotion of Statistical Capacity Building
 - □ Technical Assistance
 - Workshop/ Training

Coverage

- Selected Specific Field
 - □SITS (introduction to SITS manual)
 - □ Trade Data Analysis (its use in trade analysis and negotiation)
 - □ Leading Indicators (5 years ago)
 - □Intermediate statistics & modeling
- All AMCs, except bullet point 4
 - □ Capacity building is for both AMCs and ASEC



Main Motivation

- Support for regional integration through strengthened capacities in data collection, compilation, analysis and dissemination of comparable and quality data, and better planning and management of statistical activities
 - Part of programme thrusts (regional concerns)
 - □ Taking into account peculiarities at national level and international concerns

Funding

- External sources, including Dialogue
 Partner Countries
 - **SITS: USAID & AUSAID**
 - □ Trade Data Analysis: USAID
 - □ Leading Indicators: UNSD
 - □ Intermediate Stat & Modeling: APRIS
- DP Countries: in many other nonstatistics programme (Agriculture, Science & Tech; Customs, etc)

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Strategies of Cooperation

- International/Donor Organization
 - Limited to development of concept and plan, and to funding
- Project Proponent (could be AMCs or ASEC)
 - Implement the training
- ASEC: facilitation, resource persons
- AMCs: participants and resource persons

Assessment of Training Efficiency and Effectiveness

- The usual feedback evaluation, based on standard form
- Immediate impact: on the output of the workshop (if it is to support the workshop)
- Medium and Long-term impact: on relevant countries activities and output (webpage, Leading Indicators)

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Regional and Country Specific Factors

- Types of development intervention
 - □ Policy Initiatives
 - Establishment of Institutional mechanism
 - □ Human Capacity Building
- Main thrusts:
 - □ Regionalism
 - □ Integration
 - □ Competitiveness



Dedicated website

- Not available
- The intention is to have all materials and information posted on the web



Enhancing Training Activities

- What has been observed
 - □Issues on limited number of staff
 - Issues due to job turn-over and promotion
 - Limited and simple on-the-job training
 - Lack of experience and expertise to deal with practical/ implementation problems

Enhancing Training Activities

- Some thoughts
 - Multi-tasking supported with sufficient basic training
 - Need to have a systematic and continues training programme on basic statistics (in country or sub-regionwise)
 - ■More Practical-oriented workshops
 - □Special scheme (ASEAN-help-ASEAN)
 - □TA and workshop to develop better human-resource plan
