



What is SBR?

Statistical Business Register (SBR) is:

A Regularly updated

Structured database

Of Specific business units in a territorial area

Maintained by NSO

and Used for statistical purposes

Roles of SBR

Central Role: Coordinating mechanism for economic statistics

Through:

Foundation for creating sampling frames (live register)

Providing population of statistical units at fixed point in time (register snapshot)

Providing frame for each economic survey

Support to survey operations (data collection, response burden,..)

A source of timely data on business statistics (small areas)



Roles of SBR

Other roles

Facilitates international comparison and data exchange

Facilitates integration of business data in **Statistical Register System (SRS)**

In principle All institutional units in the national economy

That are Engaged in productive economic activities

Economic activity:

Data sources for SBR

Administrative

- Most commonly: Compulsory BR and taxation system
- Others: social security, labor, agriculture, ...

Statistical

- Economic surveys (frames drawn from SBR)
- Improvement surveys (conducted by SBR itself)

Other

- Utility supply data (tel, water, elec)
- Market info companies
- Emerging sources (big data)



Building a SBR

Cooperation

- with register holders
- vital but complex and challenging

Common identification system

- Eases combining data from administrative sources
- Improves quality and reduces cost

Linking and matching

- Challenges: duplications, dealing with sector boundaries
- Solutions: unique identifiers, probabilistic matching

Combining data sources

- Evaluate and identify most useful data sources
- A set of conversion rules for converting admin to stat units

Transforming admin to stat units

- Mainly enterprise, based on legal unit
- In few cases enterprise groups as a group of legal units (complex & need more investigation)
