 - * Release projections of population, household and labour force in one go
 - * Give ample time for them to review the projections and update their policy initiatives
 - * Projection time frame: extend from 30 years to 50 years

- ➤ IAOS is an international professional association of the ISI (International Statistical Institute)
- The Young Statisticians Prize competition is one of the major events of IAOS to encourage more young statisticians to take an active interest in official statistics.

Young Statisticians Prize 2016

- Target participants:
 - o under the age of 35
 - o Employed by an official statistical agency
- Submit papers of maximum10 pages
 - address, and propose solutions to, pressing methodological or strategic issues in official statistics

- Awards to winners:
 - 1st place: €1500,
 2-yr IAOS membership,
 certificate of award, plus
 presentation at IAOS Conference
 (with airfare and hotel)
 - 2nd place: €1000, 2-yr IAOS membership, cert.
 - 3rd place: €500, 2-yr IAOS membership, cert.
