National Statistical Office	 Develop the methods for the national SDG indicators in conjunction with related institutions; Compile the national level statistics using the data from the NSO and those from relevant institutions; and Submit the national baseline indicators.
Ministry of Finance	 Responsible for the economic development policy Responsible for harmonizing the long term national development concept with SDGs Help render assistance in providing relevant institutions with integrated management and coordination; and
UNDP	 Has an abundant experience in the implementation of MDGs Provide consultancy services in assessing SDG indicators and defining the national indicators; and Help other institutions mobilize financial resources for compiling the SDG indicators and support the enhancement of their human resources capacity.

 Number of SDG indicators will be under the responsibility of the Ministry concerned (over 30). Cooperate on compiling health and other related statistics, on providing professional recommendations, and on developing methodology.
 Number of SDG indicators will be under the responsibility of the Ministry concerned (about 20). Cooperate on compiling other related educational statistics, on providing professional recommendations, and on developing methodology.
 Number of SDG indicators will be under the responsibility of the Ministry concerned (over 40). Provide consultancy services in assessing the SDG indicators and determining the national indicators. Cooperate on compiling relevant green, environment statistics, on providing professional recommendations, and on developing methodology.





IV. INITIATIVES/ACTIVITIES TOWARDS NATIONAL SDG

- NSO has translated 17 goals, 169 targets, 304 indicators into Mongolian and sent to all ministries and related agencies.
- NSO has initiated meetings with the MOF and the UNDP.
- With the support from UNDP and UNEP, NSO recruited a national consultant Ms Gereltuya and an international consultant Mr Coulombe to make <u>assessments</u> with the aim of
 - providing an overview of national and provincial data availability in regard to the Global SDG;
 - identifying data gaps in regard to indicators for reporting against the proposed Global SDG targets;
 - creating a set of SDG indicators that are feasible for Mongolia.
- On 26 November, 2015, NSO, MOF, UNDP and UNEP jointly organized a National SDG Mainstreaming and Planning Workshop to bring together all relevant stakeholders and to present the assessment results to them.
