### **Sources of Raw Data**

#### Censuses

- Census of Population
- Census of Agriculture and Fisheries
- Census of Philippine Business and Industry

#### Surveys such as

- Labor Force Survey
- Family Income and Expenditure Survey
- Functional Literacy, Education and Mass Media Survey
- National Demographic and Health Survey
- Survey on Overseas Filipinos
- Annual Survey of Philippine Business and Industry



### Sources of Raw Data

- Administrative Records
  - Domestic Shipping
  - Foreign Trade
  - Building Permits
  - Civil Registration

## Public Awareness and Understanding of census/survey

- Identification of different target groups to solicit support and generate awareness
- Key messages delivered through available channels (radio, TV, print media, internet)
- Instructional materials on the census for schoolchildren

#### Data Dissemination Activities

- Data release launching
- Information campaign prior to the conduct of a census/survey

- Formal publications
  - Electronic format
  - Print

Labor Force Statistics	Labor Force Survey	Monthly
Family Income and Expenditure Statistics	Family Income and Expenditure Survey	Annual
Vital Statistics	Civil Registration Documents	Annual

### **NSO Data Archive**

### (http://www.census.gov.ph/nsoda)

- International standards for the documentation of NSO microdata
- Promote effective use of existing census, survey and administrative-based documents
- Provide equitable access to microdata
- Ensure long term preservation of microdata
- Provide detailed metadata and other publicly available materials



### Data Available in the Archive

Including metadata and other materials

- Survey microdata
- Census microdata
- Administrative-based microdata

### Microdata Sets Available

- Public Use Files (Anonymized)
- Licensed Files (Semi-anonymized)
- Files accessible on-site (Data enclave – sensitive data, difficult to anonymize)

### **Archiving Activities**

- Acquisition
  - Continuing activity of NSO to ensure that all collected microdata will be proficiently documented.
- Documentation
  - NSO data archivists are trained to adopt the Data Documentation Initiative (DDI) and Dublin Core (DCMI) standards
- Anonymization
  - Principles and methods for measuring risk and for anonymizing data are applied
