

Getting from point A to point B Who does what and with whom?



Internal to NSO









... Building a Programme

- Identify remaining gaps in capacity of NSSs
- Determine priorities of each NSS
- Develop work plans to address priorities
 - Integrating capacity building requirements for economic statistics in National Strategies for the Development of Statistics
 - Mobilizing (advocating for the mobilization) of national, subregional, regional and global resources (expertise and funding)
- Informal regional coordination mechanisms
