## 6. Methodology adopted, and instruments used for evaluation:-

6(a) **Evaluation of the training course, lecturers, facilities etc**.:- This is done based on the feedback taken from participants.

6(b) **Evaluation of participants after completion of the course:** - For ISS probationers, currently, a test is being taken after each module. They also have to submit a project based on the unit level data available in the country at the end of the two year training. For other short term training regular feed backs are taken from the lecturers and course coordinator/ director.

## 7. How the results of the evaluation are analyzed and used?

Feedback module helps to determine the faculty and the institute for that training. These are discussed in the meeting of Training Programme Approval Committee (TPAC), under the chairmanship of Director General (SS). TPAC based on these feedbacks decides the future course of this academy that may be further strengthened in order to build qualitatively the capacity of fresh recruits as well as inservices officers of the statistical system of the country.
