RPES action areas

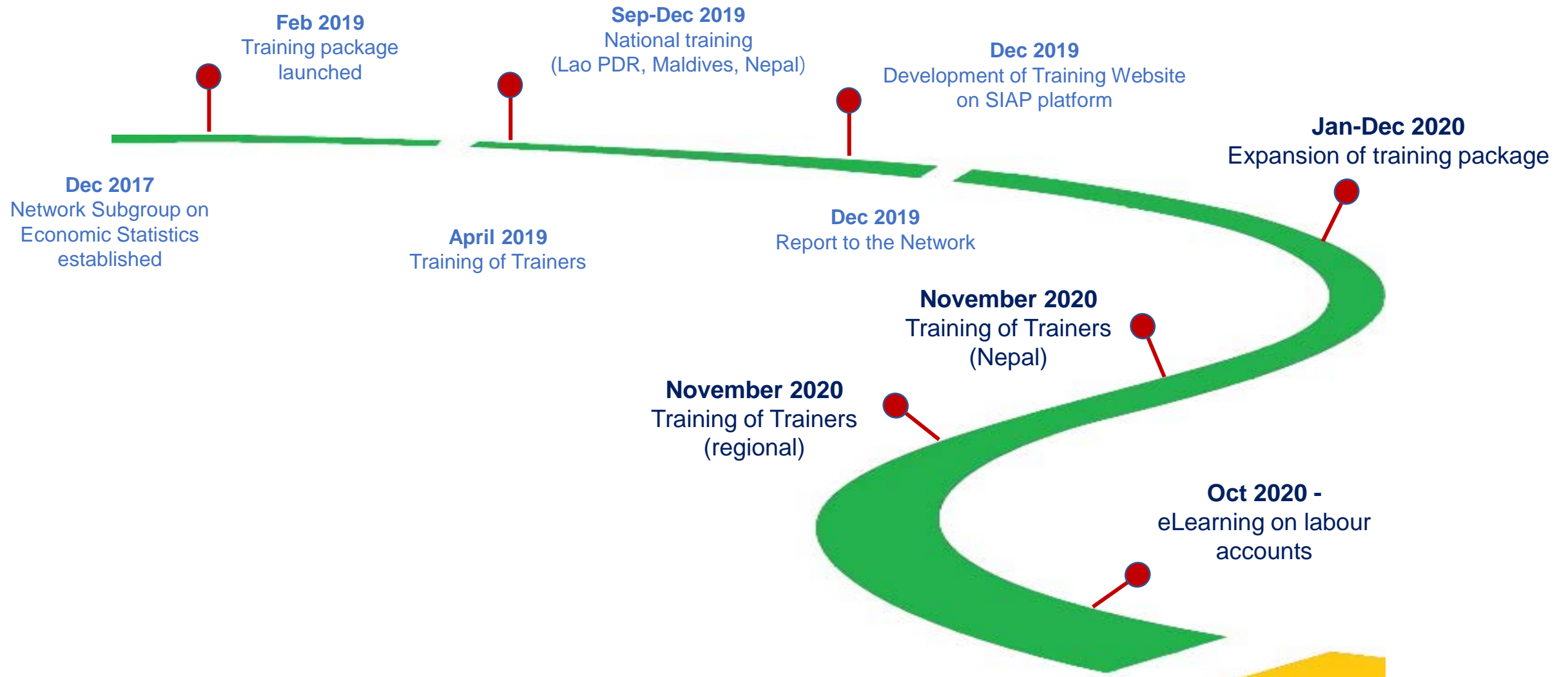
Advocacy

- Excellent facilitation

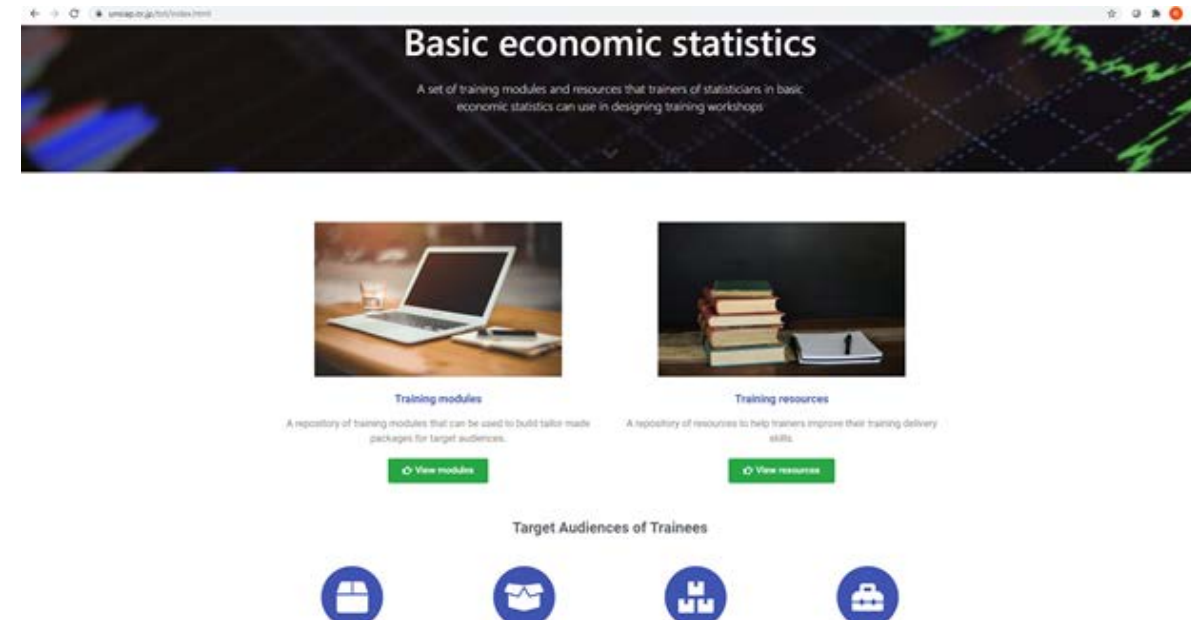
Expansion of training package
