

SGGST: Report of activities in 2020

- Subgroup on Gender Statistics training: Tasked with
 - Generating a repository of training experts on this topic
 - Generating a training curriculum on gender statistics
 - Promote the implementation of training on gender statistics across the region
 - Promote the quality of training on gender statistics across the region
- SGGST's work in 2020:
 - Training materials were finalized and peer-reviewed
 - Training curriculum is available on-line https://data.unwomen.org/resources/gender-statistics-training-curriculum
 - Virtual meeting held in October to introduce curriculum to SGGST
 - Draft template for reporting mechanism currently being finalized
 - Session on gender stats included in other training (crime)
 - E-learning modules currently being developed





Training curriculum: Take-up

- HKBU designed a course on gender statistics and storytelling, to be rolled out starting January 2021
- School of data in Kyrgyzstan is currently translating the materials to organize a course on gender statistics and the media, to be launched in January 2021
- National University of Mongolia developed a course on Gender and Economics (post-grad) for implementation on February onwards.
- BPS Indonesia is collaborating with the Ministry of Women and NGOs to organize a webinar series on gender statistics training
- SESRIC is planning a training on gender and population statistics that will utilize the training curriculum, to be delivered in Q1 2021
- PRSTI conducted training (with Paris 21) for local government, on the importance of gender statistics.
- Rep. Korea expressed interest in translating the materials to implement related training.
- On-line training module development in partnership with ESCAP & SIAP

Accreditation and standardization of the training curriculum

- As discussed during previous Network meeting, a system of accreditation is being explored
- Currently each of the training modules includes a final test, only accessible by trainers
- Accreditation will first be tested during virtual training (2021) upon
 - Attendance
 - Successful completion of final test
- Different accreditation certificate for face-to-face training
- Accredited participants will be added to repository of experts with related markings indicating accreditation

Virtual training

- Utilizing training curriculum materials
- Open to SGGST members and other interesting parties
- 25 January onwards (for 5 weeks)

Accreditation

Based on virtual training (by March 2021)

Finalize elearning

- In partnership with SIAP & ESCAP
- Ready for rollout by end of Q1



Long-term plan for capacity building on gender statistics

Other training

- Integrate GST Curriculum materials in other training (disasters)
- Targeted training on thematic areas (June 2020)
- Training for Russian speaking countries (Q3 2020)

Training for PICs

 Request from NSO representatives for weekly virtual training on communicating gender data and data visualization

F2F regional training?

- If travel restrictions are lifted, need to complete planned trainings (Pacific, SGGST)
- Integration of gender statistics training into SIAP work programme

Training in countries

- Support national training institutes, NSOs and Universities with implementation, as needed
- Provide material for translation and support as needed
- Coordinate reporting of results and calendar of events
